Report submitted was challenged for not being accessible to all - vital that inclusion included 'access all areas' approach to Delivery Partnerships work. JM commented that the approach being adopted seemed to be default statutory - a very prescriptive form of engagement. Report needed to be more action focused and engagement much wider than just the role of councillors - needed to encompass all SSP partners.

Consensus was that needed to be more accessible. SS offered support in next stage.
